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Sponsorship Package 2016/17 Walkerville Cricket Club

HISTORY:

The Walkerville Cricket Club was first mentioned in 1915. The original red-brick clubrooms, built in the 1920's, still exist behind the current facility. In the 1933/34 season the Walkerville Cricket Club won the premiership of the Adelaide and Suburban Cricket Association.

During the Second World War the club was disbanded due to a lack of numbers but was reformed in 1946 as the Walkerville District Cricket Club. Success came quickly with the 1947/1948 Prospect District Cricket Association A Grade premiership. B Grade and C Grade teams were added in the late 1940's.

The 1950's and, in particular, 1960's were a golden era. The 1953/54 A Grade premiership and then 8 A Grade premierships in 11 seasons in the 1960's. In 1964/65 and 1966/67 both A and B Grades won the premiership. The Walkerville Sports Club Rooms were opened at the oval in March 1969.

In 1971/72, Walkerville Cricket Club joined the Adelaide Turf Cricket Association and played on brand new turf wickets winning the A7 premiership in its first season. Over the next 9 years Walkerville worked its way through the grades reaching A1 in 1981/82. A Grade premierships followed in 1982/83 and 1985/86.

Lower grade premierships in 2001/02, 2005/06 and an A Grade premiership in 2009/10 as well as an LOD premiership in the same season were highlights in the first decade of the new millennium.

More recently, a C Grade premiership in 2012/13, 2014/15 Division 1 T20 Champions and A2 Minor Premiers have provided additional success.

As well as the senior ranks, junior cricket has continued to grow since the 1980's. From 7 junior teams in 2004/05 the Walkerville Cricket Club had 17 teams participate in the North Eastern Junior Cricket Association during 2015/2016.

The Walkerville Cricket Club celebrated its centenary year in 2014/15 with a function marking the milestone. At this event the club launched its Hall of Fame inducting nine Walkerville Cricket Club legends.
